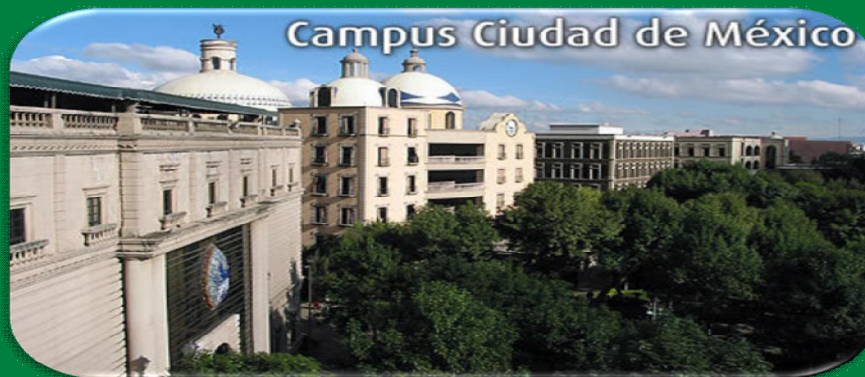
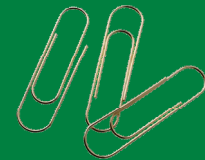




On Campus Summer Courses: Graduate - Undergraduate



As an international student, you can participate in our regular summer courses at graduate and undergraduate level at the Tecnológico de Monterrey, Mexico City Campus. We have an extensive variety of courses in different subjects with the possibility of taking one or two of them in addition to the benefit of using the facilities and participating in the different cultural and sports activities we regularly offer.



Academic Program:

The Tecnológico de Monterrey, Mexico City Campus invites you to participate in one or two courses that are regularly offered every summer at our campus. During our five-week session, you will have the possibility of taking courses in the following areas:

- **Undergraduate level**

Business: International Business Environment, E-Commerce, Consumer Behavior, International Finance, Personal and Executive Leadership, etc.

Humanities and Social Sciences: International Cooperation, International Public Law, Ethics, Person and Society, Analysis and Verbal Expression Workshop, Ethics in Professional Practice, etc.

It does not include:

- Airplane tickets, accommodation, personal expenses, meals, teaching materials, international health insurance, student visa registration costs.
- All international students must buy the International Health Insurance (approx. 100 USD) as well as the costs related to the registration of their student visa (approx. 100 USD).
- **Student Visa:** all students are required to have Student Visa at their arrival to Mexico, for which they can apply when they receive the acceptance letter.
